


#### Source data (Ciolek & Skinner) had conflicting routes




#### Sources from later periods might introduce new errors




#### Going back in time to a secondary source for Ming



#### From the Ming source (Yang Zheng Tai) a complete base map




#### The Ming source also has Ming station names
